Gospel Truths / The Gospel Changes Me - The Gospel Produces New Life

Scripture: John 15:1-11

Questions

- 1. Read John 15:1-11
- 2. Is there anything from the sermon that challenged you or that you want to talk about further?
- 3. The Good News changes our hearts; new desires and new life. Does this only happen when we accept Christ, or is it a continual process?
- 4. Changing of the heart makes us look different. How can we know our heart is affected and not just our head/knowledge? (Gal 5:22-23)
- 5. We are saved and begin producing fruit. How does fruit bearing look different as a Christian matures?
- "God's hand is never closer to us than when he prunes our lives.†When have you seen or felt this in your life?
- 7. Has God's pruning ever felt like a punishment? How did you reconcile your thoughts and feelings to know it was for your benefit? (vs 2).
- 8. It often feels easier to try and clean ourselves up rather than letting God. What does vs 4 tell us about cleaning up our own messes?
- 9. Abiding in Christ fills us. What are some practical ways you intentionally keep your eyes on Him throughout your daily life?
- 10. Take a moment to consider anything(s) that you should remove from your life that robs (distracts) you of your love of Christ.
- 11. Share a time you felt joy in knowing God was glorified through you.
- 12. Have you known someone going through a trial who had a foundation of joy? What did that look like? How did it affect those (Christian & non-Christian) looking on?
- 13. How does abiding in the vine fit with last week's main idea of the Gospel reconciling all things to Christ Jesus?
- 14. Pray that the Gospel continues to change our hearts by abiding in Him.
